DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

Support, review, delivery of proposals and reports to PNG / MAE

CDF scientific staff reviews research proposal and reports before delivery to GNP to ensure compliance with requirements and regulations. Projects involving genetic resource are processed by the Ministry of the Environment (MAE) through agreement signed with CDF. This process includes additional paperwork and follow-up besides support by CDF staff in Quito.

Account Management

CDF accounting staff with local bank identify funds transferred by visiting scientists and collaborators to CDF bank account, prior to research visit. Accounting manages and process payments as required, with the support of driver/messenger for bank transactions and logistics manager, depending on the service requested.

Quarantine de different islands

CDF Logistics personnel help scientists comply with quarantine process requirements for all equipment and supplies to be transported to other islands and camps, as the case may be. CDF service includes availability of required products such as insecticide, plastic bags, tape, boxes, protection equipment, etc.

Visa 12-III (special visas granted for international technical assistance organizations)

Pursuant CDF's agreement with the Government of Ecuador, special technical assistance or courtesy visas may be requested for visitors staying in Ecuador for over 90 days at no cost for the visitor. CDF Visiting Scientists Program coordinates paperwork with representative in Quito office who manages the process in the appropriate ministry.

Sample Export

CDF Visiting Scientists Program staff process paperwork and follow-up on requests to export non-genetic samples with GNP and Ministry of the Environment (MAE) for the exportation of genetic material. The process for genetic material involves additional paperwork both with GNP and MAE, and it requires the support of CDF's staff in Quito.

Office Space and Laboratories

Visitors may require the use of office space at CDF premises to carry out work while in Galapagos, use of internet connection as well as the use of CDF's laboratories.

Visiting Scientists

Scientists that are carrying out research without formal scientific links and or arrangements with CDF running projects. They come under a scientific permit and not included in the Science Operative Plan of the CDF.

Collaborative Scientists

Scientists that carry out projects linked to any of CDF projects and are part of or are included in CDF's Science Operative Plan.

Adjunct Scientists

Scientists with formal recognition by CDF as their work, although not necessarily linked to CDF research projects, contribute actively to the promotion of CDF's mission. These adjunct condition may develop in punctual collaborative research.
